SAMPLE THE EAST | DISCOVERING SEASONAL ROUTES

STOP #1 Vankleek Hill Farmers' Market

Address: 79 Derby Ave, Vankleek Hill ON, K0B 1R0

Find a selection of fresh, locally grown and delicious produce as well as handcrafted items.

STOP #2 Broken Kettle Bakery and Barkery

Address: 52 Main St, Vankleek Hill ON, K0B 1R0

Enjoy lunch on their patio and choose from a wide selection of soups, salads and made-to-order wraps.

STOP #3 Voyageur Provincial Park (accomodation)

Address: 1313 Front Rd, Chute-à-Blondeau ON, K0C 1B0

The park features four beaches, all of which have sand as well as a marked and buoyed swimming area.

STOP #4 Stonehouse Vineyard

Address: 21065 Lochiel Rd, Alexandria ON, K0C 1A0

Take the tasting menu and take in the peaceful surroundings or take the tour that includes all the history of location.

STOP #5 Beau's Brewery

Address: 10 Terry Fox Dr, Vankleek Hill, ON K0B 1R0

A tour of the brewery, one of the Popsilos' sites, is worth the drive. Sit on the patio for a beer and a bite.

STOP #6 Popsilos

Address: 119 Main St, Vankleek Hill, ON K0B 1R0

Silos across Prescott-Russell have been turned into works of art. Visit the Vankleek Hill famous silo while you're here.

STOP #7 Les Fruits du Poirier

Address: 2535 Concession Road 3, Saint-Eugène, ON K0B 1P0

You can pick your own raspberries but also haskap and a variety of fruits to choose from that are not common at pick your own local farms.
